

2019 ACH Executive Committee Nominations and Ballot

The ACH Executive Committee of seven members oversees administration of the Association. All members are chosen by a Nominating Committee of three members elected at the Annual General Meeting. The Nominating Committee is charged with ensuring that the Executive, as far as is possible from the members willing to accept nomination, reflects the geographic diversity of the Caribbean, as well as its languages and cultures. All members of the Executive are chosen to serve for one year; positions are renewable for a second year, but the period of service may differ.

I. OFFICERS

The President can serve two one-year terms, but not more than three consecutive years. The Vice-President succeeds the out-going President, if he or she is nominated. The Secretary-Treasurer is expected to serve for three years, and may be renewed for a second three-year term. The Conference Coordinator is also elected for a one-year term, which can be renewed for a second year.

Conference Coordinator (completed two years on the EC): Gelien Matthews, The UWI, St. Augustine. Gelien Matthews is a Lecturer in History, Department of History, The University of the West Indies, St. Augustine.
